At minimum, direct services providers for Tier1 and Tier 2 programs serving pregnant women will administer an Edinburgh Postnatal Depression Screening within the first 30 days of enrollment and again within two weeks postpartum.

- When the Edinburgh is administered, it must be scored and reviewed by the Home Based Educator.
- If the mother scores a 10 or greater, please refer to the MARC Mental Health Consultant assigned to your site.
- Home Based Educator should always review question 10 and refer to MARC Mental Health Consultant or Supervisor if there are concerns.
- A copy of the Edinburgh will need to be submitted to the MARC data team for data entry. Completed copies can be found in the health section in Childplus.
